PARTICIPATION

 Participation at the 2022 Under-17 Open National Ranking Tournament is open to all Wrestlers. A wrestler can make registration through online <u>www.wrestlingfederationofindia.org</u>. Wrestlers can also submit their Registration Form in person at WFI's Office, 21 Ashoka Road, New Delhi. The Registration Form is available at WFI's Office. The affiliated units of WFI can also send entry of interested wrestlers.

• Interested wrestler must register his/her name by <u>22/06/2022</u> for the said competition. No entry will be acceptable after the due date.

 All competitors must be Under-17 Age Group. The Wrestlers born in the years 2005 & 2006 [16-17 Years] are eligible to participate in the Under-17 [Cadet] Open National Ranking Tournament while the wrestlers born in 2007 [15 Years] may participate with medical & parental certificate.

All competitors must be in possession of a valid WFI License Book.

 Age and domicile would be verified by Birth Certificate, Adhaar Card / Passport.

It shall be open to the WFI to conduct dope test during the competition.

• If a wrestler is found to be overage, he/she will be disqualified from the competition.

 Birth Certificate is mandatory for all participants. All competitors must bring their original Birth Certificate issued by the CMO of the respective State. The Birth Certificate issued between the year 2005 to 2009 will be valid for participation in the competition. The Birth Certificate issued after 2009 will not be valid for this competition.

 Registration Fee is of Rs.1,000/- through WFI's website. If anyone wish to pay in Cash, he / she may come in Office make the Fee in Cash.

MEDAL & CERTTIFICATE

- 1 Gold, 1 Silver & 2 Bronze and Diploma Certificate in each weight category.
- Merit certificate will be given only up to 10th Rank and no certificate will be given to those securing rank after 10th.
